## CAMPGROUND POLICIES



## TO MAKE SURE THAT EVERYONE ENJOYS THEIR STAY HERE AND IS SAFE.

No motorized vehicle of any kind including e-bikes, cycles, mopeds, atvs/utvs, skateboards or scooters may be ridden in the park. If a motorized bike, atv/utvs or cycle is brought to the campground, permission must be granted from the office to park the vehicle at the site. You are allowed to take it from the site to the road and the road back to the site. Bicycles MUST be ridden on Gravel or Blacktop roads only. Please stay off the hills to save our grass and avoid injury. No Golf Carts except Staff. Motorized scooters are allowed for use by a handicapped person only.

SPEED LIMIT: Five miles per hour.

QUIET HOUR: 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Patio lights MUST be off when you turn in. Music must not be heard outside of your site.

PETS: We welcome two pets per site. Please keep them leashed and clean up after them. Pets are not allowed in buildings or in the beach area. Barking will not be tolerated. IF THE PET IS UNLEASHED AFTER BEING TOLD, YOU MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

VISITORS TO YOUR SITE: They must register at the office BEFORE GOING TO YOUR SITE and pay \$2.00 per person. Day guests must leave the park by 10:00 p.m, If you know you are having guests, you can pay ahead and get a car pass for them. We are required to have names and addresses for security and your safety. Vehicles are required to have a car pass or visitor pass and have it displayed when the office rides around.

FIREWORKS are prohibited. If you use them, you will be asked to leave.

CAMPFIRES: Make sure to purchase firewood at the office before it closes. NO WOOD may be brought into the park from anywhere because of the discovery of the Ash borer and the Gypsy Moth in Wisconsin.

ONE CAMPING UNIT per site. Additional tent on a site is \$20.00 per night. No more than 6 people to a site. Two vehicles or one vehicle and a boat are allowed on the site. Please check at the office for additional parking. No person under the age of 18 may be left in the site alone.

GARBAGE: Please recycle and take to the dumpster on your way out. CARDBOARD MUST be broken down and taken down to the tenting area. No carpet or large items please. They must be taken with you. All recycling materials should be dumped out of the bag.

POSITIVELY NO CUTTING OF TREES OR DRIVING NAILS INTO TREES. NO CHAIN SAWS ALLOWED EXCEPT BY MANAGEMENT. DAMAGING TREES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EVICTION FROM THE PARK AND POSSIBLE LEGAL ACTION.

VEHICLE AND CAMPER WASHING IS PROHIBITED as well as using a washer and dryer in your Camper.

CELL PHONE CALLS FROM CAMPERS IN THE PARK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. PLEASE COME DOWN TO THE STORE UNLESS IT IS AN EMERGENCY.

WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS OR INJURY TO OUR GUESTS OR LOSS OF MONEY OR VALUABLES OF ANY KIND

MANAGEMENT HAS THE RIGHT TO ASK ANYONE TO LEAVE WHO DOES NOT FOLLOW THESE RULES OR CAUSES A DISTURBANCE OR BOTHERS OTHER GUESTS.

TO SAVE OUR TREES, NO FIREWOOD MAY BE BROUGHT IN FROM ANYWHERE. FIREWOOD MUST BE PURCHASED AT THE OFFICE.
