

**WELCOME TO WEST BAY CAMPING RESORT
CAMPGROUND POLICIES**

To make sure that each and every one of you enjoys your stay with us, please follow these guidelines.

SPEED LIMIT: Five miles per hour. No motorized bikes, cycles, mopeds, atvs, skateboards or scooters may be ridden in the park. Bicycles **MUST** be ridden on Gravel or Blacktop roads only. Please stay off the hills to save our grass. No Golf Carts except Staff.

QUIET HOUR: 10:30 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Patio lights **MUST** be off when you turn in. Music must not be heard outside of your site.

PETS: We welcome two pets per site. Please keep them leashed and clean up after them. Pets are not allowed in buildings or in the beach area. Barking will not be tolerated.

VISITORS TO YOUR SITE: They must register at the office **BEFORE GOING TO YOUR SITE** and pay \$2.00 per person. Day guests must leave the park by 10:30 p.m. If you know you are having guests, you can pay ahead and get a car pass for them. We are required to have names and addresses for security and your safety. Vehicles are required to have a car pass or visitor pass and have it displayed when the office rides around.

FIREWORKS are prohibited. If you use them, you will be asked to leave.

CAMPFIRES: Make sure to purchase firewood at the office before it closes. **NO WOOD** may be brought into the park from anywhere because of the discovery of the Ash borer and the Gypsy Moth in Wisconsin. If you bring firewood into the campground West Bay employees will ask you to turn it over to us for disposal. We cannot reimburse you for your wood. Firewood is available at the store.

ONE CAMPING UNIT per site. Additional tent on a site is \$20.00 per night. No more than 6 people to a site. Two vehicles or one vehicle and a boat are allowed on the site. Please check at the office for additional parking. No person under the age of 18 may be left in the site alone.

GARBAGE: Please recycle and take to the dumpster on your way out. **CARDBOARD MUST** be broken down and taken down to the tenting area. No carpet or large items please. They must be taken with you.

POSITIVELY NO CUTTING OF TREES OR DRIVING NAILS INTO TREES. NO CHAIN SAWS ALLOWED EXCEPT BY MANAGEMENT. DAMAGING TREES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EVICTION FROM THE PARK AND POSSIBLE LEGAL ACTION.

VEHICLE AND RIG WASHING IS PROHIBITED as well as using a washer and dryer in your Rig.

CELL PHONE CALLS FROM CAMPERS IN THE PARK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. PLEASE COME DOWN TO THE STORE UNLESS IT IS AN EMERGENCY.

IN CASE OF SEVERE WEATHER, THE SIDE DOOR TO THE LAUNDROMAT IS OPEN. NO REFUNDS FOR WEATHER or WEATHER RELATED POWER OUTAGES. MANAGEMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACTS OF NATURE.

WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS OR INJURY TO OUR GUESTS OR LOSS OF MONEY OR VALUABLES OF ANY KIND
